SUMMARY:

James Bowling's Brass Band Bazaar is a neighborhood festival named after Sylvan Park's founder that connects our rich history and vibrant future. Music/Food/Fun - Saturday Sept. 28, 2019 from 10am-4pm at 45th Ave. N. and Murphy Rd. in Sylvan Park.

DESCRIPTION:

James Bowling's Brass Band Bazaar (JB4) is a festival named after Sylvan Park's founder and calling back to circa 1900 when the neighborhood's founding was kicked off with a brass band and cannon fire. The event brings together neighbors and businesses in Sylvan Park and surrounding neighborhoods for a day filled with live music, a local vendor bazaar, delicious food, and fun for the whole family.

The festival takes place from 10am - 4pm on Saturday September 28, 2019 at the intersection of 45th Ave. N. and Murphy Rd. in Sylvan Park. Entrance is free and gates will be located on the North and South sides of 45th Ave. N.

The event features live music, local artists, tasty food and drinks, and plenty of kids activities. Music will include local high school marching bands and a professional brass band. The Kids Zone will have bouncy houses, face paint, and free kids yoga classes. The Nashville Predators' Energy Team is also going to be there handing out swag and taking part in the festivities.

JB4 is brought to you by the Sylvan Park Community Group (SPCG), a non-profit focused on building community by supporting local organizations and establishing new neighborhood events. SPCG's mission is to bring neighbors together by celebrating the past, present and future of one of Nashville's great iconic neighborhoods.
